Cybele, also called Dindymene, Berecynthica and Magna Mater as well because she was the mother of the Gods, as because she was the Goddess of the Earth, from which so many things are produced, is seated in a Chariot drawn by lions, crowned with Towers. She is attended by Spring, Summer, Autumn & Winter and a long procession of Shepherds who acknowledged her as their tutelary Goddess and called her Magna Pales. In front of the procession are two Satyrs or Bachanalions bearing fruit and on the left Pan also called Sylvanus the most distinguished of the rural Gods the son of Mercury who assumed the figure of a goat; hence he had the fest and beard of a goat and horns on his head. He was beloved by the Nymphs who had put themselves under his protection and danced at the sound of his lute. In the distance is the Temple and River dedicated to Cybele.
