


A UNIQUE WILKIE.

A picture of world-wide celebrity—Sir David Wilkie's "Jew's Harp"—the property of a Yorkshire lady, will, we understand, be offered for sale by Messrs. Puttick and Simpson, Leicester-square, London, early in August next. The work, which is stated to have been painted in 1809, and is on panel 10in. by 8in., is fully referred to in Allan-Cunningham's "Life of Sir David Wilkie, R.A." The picture is stated to be the only known important example by Wilkie outside one of the great National Galleries.
